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**MUDJJ CONDEMNS DOMINICAN CANDIDATE CARLOS PE A'S
TERRITORIAL THREAT AGAINST HAITI**

PORT-AU-PRINCE, HAITI — MUDJJ (Movement Unforgettable Dessalines Jean-Jacques) today issued a formal condemnation of statements made by Dominican presidential candidate Carlos Pe a, who has publicly threatened to claim up to 40% of Haiti's national territory.

The Threat:

On August 19, 2026, Pe a announced on his X account that his party, Generaci n de Servidores (GenS), would "recover the territory that Haitians have taken from us" and create four new Dominican provinces on Haitian land . He estimates this claimed territory at nearly 40% of present-day Haiti .



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The Historical Ignorance:

Peña justifies his threat by claiming he only recognizes the 1777 Treaty of Aranjuez, which established colonial boundaries between Spain and France . He has willfully and dangerously dismissed the definitive border treaties signed by sovereign states in 1929 and 1936 as "illegal" . His argument that the 1929 treaty is invalid because President Louis Borno was "unconstitutional" is a legally baseless attempt to rewrite history .

The Danger:

Peña has tied his territorial claim to a broader anti-Haitian platform, including threats of "the largest deportations ever seen" and a promise to prohibit Haitian culture . This pattern of hostile rhetoric is a direct threat to regional peace and stability.

MUDJJ's Response:

MUDJJ categorically rejects Peña's claims. The border between Haiti and the Dominican Republic is definitively established by binding international treaties signed in the 20th century. Any attempt to revise these borders is a violation of international law and an act of aggression against the Haitian people.



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We call on the international community, the Organization of American States (OAS), CARICOM, and all peace-loving nations to:

1. Publicly condemn these inflammatory and dangerous statements.
2. Reaffirm the existing, legally binding borders between Haiti and the Dominican Republic.
3. Call on the Dominican government and its political leadership to disavow this irresponsible rhetoric.

Haiti's sovereignty is non-negotiable. We will not be intimidated. We will respond with the truth of history and the unshakeable conviction that our borders are inviolable.
