Subject: URGENT: MUDJJ's Formal Challenge to the Security Council — End the Occupation, Dismantle the Corrupt Network, and Bring MUDJJ to the Table

Your Excellencies,

On behalf of MUDJJ (Movement Unforgettable Dessalines Jean-Jacques) and our coalition NSA (Nou Se Ayiti), we address you not with a plea, but with a formal challenge based on documented facts and the urgent demands of the Haitian people.

As the Security Council convenes to discuss the crisis in Haiti, we demand that you confront the truth: the international community's approach has failed because it has refused to address the root cause of the crisis—the corrupt network of politicians and oligarchs who created, financed, and continue to arm the gangs.

1. THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS TREATING THE SYMPTOM, NOT THE DISEASE

Your representatives correctly identify the brutality of the Kenscoff massacre, where at least 47 people were killed, including 22 executed in a church. Your calls for "breaking the cycle of impunity" are welcome.



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However, you consistently refuse to name the disease: the corrupt network of politicians and oligarchs who created, financed, and continue to arm the gangs.

This network includes:

- Prime Minister Alix Didier Fils-Aimé — an unelected leader imposed by the international community.
- Reginald Boulos and Dimitri Vorbe — oligarchs accused by the U.S. government of funding and supporting the gangs.
- Pierre Espérance — accused of being a central figure in the assassination plot of President Jovenel Moïse and the possession of his personal notebook.

You cannot break the cycle of impunity if you refuse to name those who benefit from it.

2. THE "SOLUTION" IS A FAILED OCCUPATION

The Security Council now calls for more troops, just as you did with the failed Kenyan mission. You have offered no plan to dismantle the network that enables the violence.

As your own Special Representative admitted, "security operations will not be sufficient to produce sustainable security gains" without measures to restore state authority. This proves our point: you are funding occupation, not liberation.

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Meanwhile, Erik Prince's Vectus Global has a 10-year contract with the Fils-Aimé government to fight gangs and collect taxes. According to Human Rights Watch, at least 1,243 people have been killed by drone strikes associated with Vectus Global's operations, including 43 civilians and 17 children.

This is not security. This is re-colonization.

3. OUR WARNINGS WERE IGNORED — HISTORY HAS PROVEN US RIGHT

In 2024, MUDJJ wrote to the UN Human Rights Council, the Kenyan High Court, and the African Union. We warned that the Kenyan police deployment was a threat to Haiti, citing their documented history of brutality and sexual violence.

Our warnings were ignored. The mission failed. The abuses occurred—exactly as we predicted.

In 2025, we exposed the Erik Prince mercenary scandal. We exposed the gang-state alliance. We exposed the fraudulent electoral process.

The international community ignored us. The crisis worsened—exactly as we predicted.

Now, the Security Council meets again to discuss the same crisis, with the same failed solutions.

We are done asking. We are demanding.



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4. OUR DEMANDS

We demand the following immediate actions:

1. Sever All Ties with the Corrupt Network

The Security Council must publicly condemn Prime Minister Alix Didier Fils-Aimé and the entire corrupt network and demand an immediate end to all international support for them.

2. End the Mercenary Occupation

The Council must call for the immediate cancellation of all contracts with Erik Prince's Vectus Global and any other private military companies operating in Haiti.

3. Arrest, Not Just Sanction

The international community must support the immediate arrest and prosecution of the political and financial backers of the gangs, including those who financed the assassination of President Jovenel Moïse.

4. Bring MUDJJ to the Table

The Council must formally recognize MUDJJ as the legitimate government-in-waiting and invite us to participate in all negotiations for a clean, Haitian-led transition with Emmanuel G. Morel as Prime Minister.



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5. A FRESH START WITHOUT THE CORRUPT POLITICIANS

The Haitian people do not need more troops. They do not need more sanctions. They need a clean break from the corrupt network that has destroyed their nation.

MUDJJ offers that clean break.

We have the evidence. We have the plan. We have the movement. We have the candidate.

We are ready to lead. We are ready to restore security, stability, and dignity to Haiti.

6. CONCLUSION

The era of hypocrisy is over. The Haitian people demand justice, not more military force. The international community must choose: continue funding the assassins, or stand with the Haitian people.

There is no middle ground.

We await your response. We will not be silent. We will not forget. We will not stop.
